Suleiman, from Somalia, came to my office to tell me that his wife, 8 children and 1 grand-daughter were in a refugee camp in Dadab, Kenya (close to Nairobi) waiting to come to St. Louis. He was upset because the Kenyan police came and arrested three of his children and sent them back to Mogadishu, Somalia. He talked with his wife and she said she did not have food or shoes or a mattress to sleep on. We are fortunate that we have a missionary in Nairobi, Kenya that I could call to see if he could help this family in Kenya. He was able to send someone that could speak Somali to give some assistance to his family. Please pray for this family to be united in St. Louis. Also pray for their safety while in the refugee camp. We love Suleiman and have prayed with him several times for his family. He lives with another son here in St. Louis.
